“2+2” serves as a special opportunity not only for the high school students, but also the GSWB community and its corporate partners.

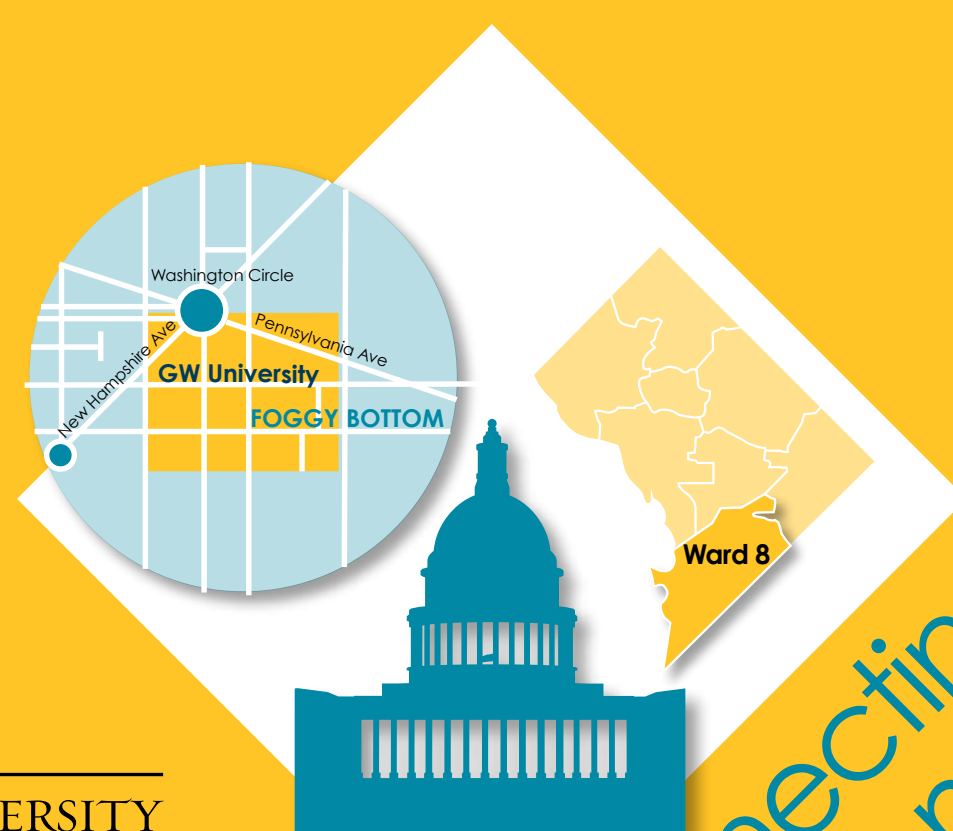
### Next: Inspiration and “double benefits”.
